Actions of the Michigan Bird Records Committee for 2021

This is the 32nd report of the Michigan Bird Records Committee (MBRC), covering the committee's actions during the year 2021.

In 2021, the MBRC consisted of regular members Adam M. Byrne (Clinton Co.), Louie Dombroski (Arizona), Skye Haas (Marquette Co.), Lyle Hamilton (Livingston Co.), Darrell Lawson (Charlevoix Co.), David Pavlik (Kent Co.), and Chace Scholten (Ottawa Co.). Alternate members included Geoff Malosh (Ohio) and Andrew Simon (Macomb Co.). Pavlik chaired the committee and Byrne was the secretary.

In 2021, the MBRC made final decisions on 126 records with 78 (62%) of these records resulting in acceptance at some taxonomic level. The term "acceptance" means at least one individual reported was accepted, even if it was at a broader taxonomic level than the original submission. This would include a bird submitted as a Magnificent Frigatebird but ultimately accepted as Frigatebird sp. (*Fregata* sp.).

Some status changes for 2020 were determined in early 2021. Arctic Tern moved from Casual to Regular and will remain on the review list through 2023. Sage Thrasher moved from Accidental to Casual. Cassin's Finch was added to the state list with Accidental status.

Several species had a change in their occurrence status at the end of 2021. Eurasian Wigeon remained with Regular status through the three-year probationary period and is no longer on the review list. Mexican Violetear moved from Casual to Accidental. Yellow-crowned Night Heron moved from Casual to Regular and will remain on the review list through 2024. Glossy Ibis moved from Casual to Regular and will remain on the review list through 2024. Roseate Spoonbill was added to the state list with Accidental status. Short-billed Gull moved from Casual to Accidental. Neotropic Cormorant moved from Accidental to Casual. Green-tailed Towhee moved from Casual to Accidental. Blue Grosbeak remained Regular after its three-year probationary period and is no longer on the review list.

This past summer, the American Ornithological Society split Mew Gull into two species – Shortbilled Gull and Common Gull. Short-billed Gull is comprised of the North American subspecies *L. c. brachyrhynchus*), while Common Gull includes "Common Gull" (*L. c. canus*) and "Kamchatka Gull" (*L. c. kamtschatschensis*). Both forms of Common Gull have been reported in Eastern North America and should be considered serious possibilities to occur in Michigan. Michigan currently has nine accepted "Mew Gull" records, only one of which was identified and accepted as a Short-billed Gull. The remaining eight records were only accepted as generic Mew Gulls and warrant reconsideration at the subspecies level. The Committee agreed to reconsider the remaining eight accepted records as Short-billed Gull, with the idea that if any did not meet standards for that species, members could request reconsideration as Common Gull, if they felt that was more important. Otherwise records rejected as Short-billed Gull will still be considered accepted as Short-billed/Common Gull. For accepted records, the following information is provided: number of birds, dates, location (counties in italics), and contributors. The number of state records is included after the species name. All contributors that provided documentation are listed, the finder, if known, is listed and underlined, even if they did not provide documentation.
